My father purchased this 1966 mustang coupe for my mother from Robert H. Loud Ford in Pasadena Ca in December 1965. It was equipped with factory air conditioning which till this day is still working. Also it came with power steering, power brakes and also a bench seat. My parents loved to take it on the mountain roads on the way to their vacation home in Big Bear Lake. After my mother passed away in 1977, my father transferred the title to me knowing how much I regretted selling my 68 2+2 big block GT Mustang. My hot rod side temped me many times to modify the '66 coupe but I have decided to keep it stock because that's the way my parents drove it off the lot. This '66 has not always looked this good a few years later after I took position of the mustang thing's in my life started to change. Major home remodel and garage expansion, and divorce and then apartment living. Not having somewhere to store my classic indoors I had to turn to alternative storage for the next 14 years. Over the years I procrastinated on finishing the interior and replacing some of the chrome. Then one day Joan started calling various restoration shops.
